Stitches of Love Quilting Ministry Blessing today - Today you are surrounded by the many quilts and blankets created by our quilting ministry group this year. These quilts will be blessed today and then distributed to several organizations including: The Linus Project, Milwaukee Women's Center, The Lutheran Home, CareNet; Pine Ridge Reservation, Ronald McDonald House, Allies for Teens in Foster Care. 164 blankets and quilts were completed this year, as well as 10 receiving blankets given to baptism families at St. Matthew's, 82 pillowcases, 3 bed runners, and 10 Christmas bags to Allies for Teens. Bev Etzelmueller is the leader of this group, now in its 20th year at St. Matthew's. Everyone is welcome to join the ministry, which meets four times a year. A total of 3,002 quilts have been completed since this ministry began in 2004. What an accomplishment!
